

## **How to Get Started Checklist**

## **Scouts:** ■ BSA Youth Application Follow link on Troop728 Website - https://my.scouting.org/VES/OnlineReg/1.0.0/?tu=UF-MB-492taa0728 This should take you to a page where they can join or transfer. For a transfer it may ask for a BSAID number. After entering the required information and paying any required membership fees an electronic join request will be sent to Troop 728. If you are transferring and have a current registration with another unit there should be no charge however you will be responsible for keeping your membership active going forward under the new Council/National BSA subscription based model. Since members will be taking care of their own registration through online registration we will no longer be collecting yearly Troop/membership dues. Instead we will collect a \$50 one time fee at the time of joining to cover part of the joining and material costs. ■ BSA Medical Form Anyone attending Troop outings will be required to provide a medical form to the Troop before the outing if they don't have one on file already or if it is expired. Medical forms are good for 1 year from the date signed. Parts A & B are required for any event lasting less than 72 hours (most day/weekend events) and Part C is required for events lasting over 72 hours (summer camp, etc.), part C requires a doctor's signature. The current medical form can be found here: https://filestore.scouting.org/filestore/HealthSafety/pdf/680-001 ABC.pdf ■ Adult/Family Information Sheet: We will ask each family to fill out an adult information sheet, there is space for 2 adults to provide their information on one sheet. This information includes things that will be needed for outings and other administrative purposes, this along with the information from the online application allows us to create a member profile for them with Troop 728. Adult Information Collection Form is attached to this email and available on the Troop website, www.Troop728.com Troop 728 Activity Permission Slip Follow link on Troop 728 Website Scout hand carries to each camp out load out and gives to his driver Uniform and Patches Tan Uniform shirt & patches (cascade pacific council, world crest)

Troop 728 patch provided to scout upon receipt of all paperwork, Patrol patch ordered within patrol

Troop 728 will provide a hat and neckerchief specific to Troop 728

## Parents:

Adult Registration (optional - required for overnight events):

As per National BSA requirements updated 9/1/2023, all Adults attending any overnight activities are required to be registered with the BSA, complete a background check and online Youth Protection Training (<a href="may.scouting.org">my.scouting.org</a>) (both are part of registration). You can use the same link above to register for membership with Troop 728, if you are already registered with another unit you can use the link to register as a multiple at no additional cost. If you are not yet a member you will need to pay your membership fee at the time of registration, this is a part of the new Council/National BSA subscription based registration program. If you choose to volunteer/participate in a leadership or organizational support role (there are many options) the Troop can reimburse your registration fees back to your youth's Scout Account for use towards future Scouting expenses.
